

## Checklist Equipment

### Essentials

- Tickets
- Passport
- Vaccination certificate
- Credit card(s)
- Cash
- Traveller's cheques
- Travel insurance policy
- Phone number of your Travel Medical Insurances emergency hotline
- Copies of all documents (very important in case of losing your documents, please store separate!)

### Also indispensable

- Money belt
- Sun glasses
- Sunscreen
- Headgear
- Pocket lamp
- Additional batteries for pocket lamp
- Pocketknife
- Small screwdriver (for conking glasses)
- Camera
- Films (better too much than too little)
- Spare batteries for camera
- Rechargeable batteries, charger for video or digital cameras, Digitalkamera, mobile phone
- Mosquito net (not provided by all accomodations; sometimes the nets are completely threadbare)

### For craftsmen and housewives

- Detergent
- Clothespins
- Cords
- Sewing kit
- Adhesive tape (textile; for repairing clothes and tents)
- Insulating tape

- Steel nails (e. g. for fixing a mosquito net)
- Wire
- Instant glue
- Ballistol (Multi-purpose oil; ideal for maintaining, lubricating, cleaning, even caring of skin and wounds )
- Pocket calculator (currency converter)
- Nonbreakable mug
- Cigarette lighter
- Waterproof bag
- Plastic bags and sacs
- Rubber bands
- Alarm clock
- Soft tissues/Kitchen roll
- Moist wipes (unsurpassable when there is no shower)

### For your comfort

- Dictionary
- Mosquito coils
- Binoculars
- Rain repellent clothes
- Windproof trouser and jacket (morning temperatures are often flipping cold)
- Nail file and scissors

### Additional extras for camping

- Sleeping bag
- Small pillow (filch it from an airline, these pillows are gorgeous...)
- Repair kit for tents and (selfinflating) mattresses
- Small bag (to take along all essentials and basics to the tent, don't leave them behind in the car)
